**RE: 2021 PORTAGE AVENUE PAVEMENT RENEWALS –
ST. CHARLES STREET TO DAVID STREET**

Please be advised eastbound and westbound Portage Avenue from St. Charles Street to David Street is scheduled for an asphalt pavement renewal project in Summer/Fall 2021.

Construction start: July 2021
Duration: 12 weeks

The proposed work will include: drainage infrastructure improvements, milling of existing asphalt pavement, full depth concrete joint and slab repairs, partial curb and sidewalk renewals, and paving of new asphalt overlay.

Construction will have an impact on traffic, pedestrians, and access. Details and instructions regarding construction and traffic staging, access impacts, parking, pedestrian accommodations, and garbage/recycling collection will be provided in a second notice issued approximately one week prior to construction.

If you have accessibility concerns, special access requirements, planned special events, known underground appurtenances such as sprinklers or lighting cables within 6m of the Portage Avenue curb line, or any other questions regarding this construction, please contact Kelly Groff at Kelly.Groff@wsp.com.
