Dear Mr. Roblin:

At the last meeting of our Municipal Council, I was directed to communicate with you submitting for your consideration the following road improvement in this Municipality and on which the Municipal Council feel we may have financial assistance from our Provincial Government:

1. The paving of Des Meurons from Regal Ave. to Carriere Ave. This street is being used as a second means of access from the Trans-Canada Highway after it enters on to St. Anne's Road through to St. Boniface, and other points West, North, and East, and with this situation in view, the paving of the street appears urgent, and financial assistance is of course necessary.

2. The construction of a bridge over the Red River connecting up Edinburgh Street in this Municipality, and Osborne Street in the City of Winnipeg. This is most urgent as the vehicle traffic over the Elm Park bridge and through Kingston Crescent and Kingston Row is becoming so heavy and facilities are far from adequate to handle this mounting traffic. This item, of course, would require a major Government contribution.

We would appreciate your very kind consideration of these two items, and trust that at some early date Council may have the opportunity of meeting with you in connection with this submission.
