

By Law No. 20. A By Law to authorize an assessment for City purposes for the year 1874. Dated 2nd September 1874. Read a first, second and third time and passed. The Rule being suspended by unanimous vote for that purpose. 2nd September 1874. A.M. Brown, City Clerk. By Law No. 20. A By Law to authorize an assessment for City Purposes for the year One thousand Eight hundred and Seventy four. Whereas it is expedient and necessary to raise by a Tax upon the real and personal property of the City of Winnipeg a sum of money for the public uses of the City for the current year. Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Winnipeg in Council Assembled Enacts as follows:

1. That there shall be raised, levied and collected a tax of one cent on the dollar upon the assessed value of the real and personal property in the City of Winnipeg to and for the public uses of the Said City during the current year.
2. That there shall be levied and collected on and from the owners possessors or harborers of Dogs, within the City of Winnipeg, the sum of Two Dollars yearly for Each and Every dog within the Said City.
3. That there shall be levied and collected on and from the owners possessors or harborers of Bitches within the City of Winnipeg the Sum of Three Dollars yearly for Each and Every bitch within the said City.
