Thompson building for public viewing. His Worship encouraged MIAC members to view the display and give feedback to the Indigenous Relations Division.</p> <p>The Second Annual Accord signing will be held on Wednesday, June 20, 2018 with 36 new signatories expected to sign the Accord.</p> <p>His Worship asked members of MIAC to provide guidance related to reconciliation associated with street and facility names.</p> <p>MIAC discussed research published by the Angus Reid Institute on June 7, 2018 pertaining to Canadians' sentiments toward Indigenous Peoples' matters. 3	<b>Accord Update:</b>	<p>Annual Report Presentation provided to MIAC by the Indigenous Relations Division regarding the first year of the Accord signing.</p> <p>Signing Ceremony Second Annual Signing Ceremony to be held on June 20, 2018. New partners will be added to the circle. There are 117 partners to date, 81 initial and 36 new signatories.</p> <p>Business Plan – Asper School of Business Through the MBA program, the Asper School of Business has helped create a business plan to promote the Accord through sustainability, encouraging momentum, and promotional initiatives.</p> <p>Oshki Annishinabe Nigaaniwak – Annual compilation video viewing MIAC viewed the compilation video produced by youth in the Oshki Annishinabe Nigaaniwak program.</p>
