CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Residents and Businesses on Salter Street
RE: 2021 Salter Street Pavement Renewals – Slaw Rebchuk to Cathedral Avenue

Please be advised the 2021 Salter Street Pavement Renewals Project is scheduled to begin in April 2021.

Construction start: April 26, 2021
Duration: To be complete by November 5, 2021
Traffic Implications: Salter Street from Slaw Rebchuk Bridge to Cathedral Avenue and all intersecting streets

Work includes patching and renewing the existing concrete pavement where required and renewing most of the curbs and sidewalks. We will also repair the sewer where required and improve drainage. The road rehabilitation work will be completed with a thick layer of new asphalt and new sod landscaping where required. There will also be smaller sections of road reconstruction between Pritchard Avenue and Burrows Avenue, and Alfred Avenue and Redwood Avenue, where all the road and curb will be removed. Reconstruction areas will be completed with finished concrete. This work will improve drainage and rideability and extend the life of the roadway.

On April 25, 2021 the City of Winnipeg will set up the lane closure from north of Selkirk Avenue to Cathedral, closing Salter Street to southbound traffic at Cathedral Avenue, and moving northbound traffic to the west lane north of Selkirk Avenue. Side streets and back lanes will be maintained whenever possible. Once the work north of Selkirk is complete and reopened to traffic, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction from the Slaw Rebchuk Bridge to Selkirk Avenue. Garbage and recycling pickup will remain unchanged. Parking on Salter Street will also be temporarily removed during construction.

Pedestrian access to residences and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Northbound Transit service will be maintained on Salter and southbound service will be rerouted to Main St between Cathedral Ave and Selkirk Ave. Some stops may be temporarily relocated or closed for short periods of time during construction.
