

## Courtesy Tow Service Notice

The City of Winnipeg's Transportation Management Centre (TMC) has determined that your vehicle is blocking traffic flow and creating a safety hazard on the roadway.



Under the Winnipeg Parking Bylaw your vehicle could be ticketed and towed at your expense, however your vehicle will receive a courtesy tow instead which will move your vehicle to a nearby location such as a side street or off-street parking location while you wait for your own towing service. If requested, the tow truck operator will take you with your vehicle to the nearby location.

If you have already called for your own tow truck, you will need to contact them again to advise them about the new location of your vehicle for pick-up.

If the courtesy tow relocates your vehicle to a time-restricted parking space, your vehicle will be exempt from the parking restrictions for a 24-hour grace period from the time of the tow. If your vehicle remains in the time-restricted parking space beyond the 24-hour grace period, your vehicle may be ticketed and towed to the towing company's compound at your expense.

You have the right to refuse the courtesy tow. However, if you refuse you may be ticketed and towed at your own expense for blocking a lane of traffic.
