## **Notice of Upcoming Construction in the St. James Neighbourhood**

Starting the week of August 12, 2013, we will begin installing new land drainage sewers to help protect homes in this area from basement flooding. The new sewers will also help protect the water quality of our rivers and Lake Winnipeg by reducing the frequency of combined sewer overflows.

### **Construction area**

This work will take about five to six months and will include installing sewers on:

- Ness Avenue – between Berry Street and Madison Avenue
- Madison Street – between Silver Avenue and Ness Avenue
- Kensington Street – between Silver Avenue and Ness Avenue

### **Services maintained during construction**

- Your water and sewer service will not be interrupted.
- Your recycling and garbage collection will not be affected.

### **Parking and traffic during construction**

We will always maintain:

- access to your private approach,
- at least one lane of eastbound and westbound traffic on Ness Avenue.

There will be some parking and traffic restrictions starting the week of August 12, 2013:

- Ness Avenue from Berry Street to Madison Avenue will have lane closures and periodic traffic restrictions.
- Century Street will have lane closures and traffic restrictions around Ness at different stages of construction.
- Traffic will be limited to local access only in the rest of the construction area.

Tri-Core Projects Manitoba Ltd. will be the contractor for this project.

To keep your children safe, please keep them away from the construction site at all times.

We understand this work may cause you some inconvenience and we appreciate your patience.
