Notice of Upcoming Work in St. James Neighbourhood

Starting March 10, 2014, we will begin a two- week project to complete our work to install new land drainage sewers on Ness Avenue between Brooklyn Street and Berry Street.

These sewers are part of a program to help protect homes in this area from basement flooding. The new sewers will also help protect the water quality of our rivers and Lake Winnipeg by reducing the frequency of combined sewer overflows.

During this sewer construction, your water and sewer service will not be interrupted, and your recycling and garbage collection will not be affected.

Traffic restrictions during construction

1. Ness Avenue – King Edward Street to Hampton Street

- Temporary lane changes to maintain eastbound and westbound traffic

2. Brooklyn and Berry Street – Ness Avenue to Silver Avenue

- No access to Brooklyn and Berry Street from Ness Avenue

3. Brooklyn and Berry Street – Ness Avenue to Portage Avenue

Right turns allowed only onto:

- Brooklyn and Berry Street going east on Ness Avenue,
- Ness Avenue going north on Brooklyn and Berry Street.

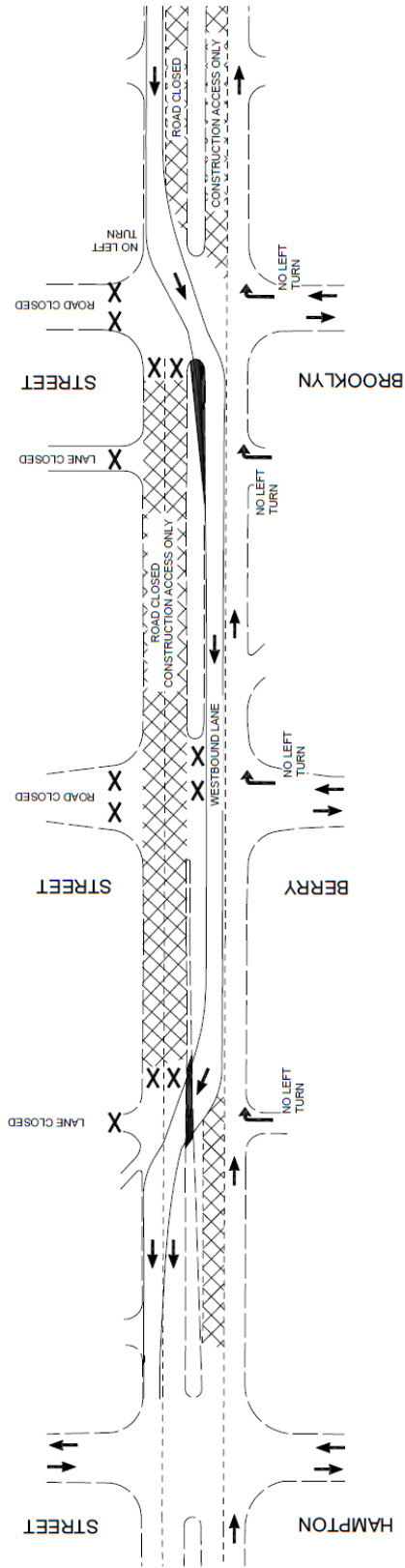
